

The City of Avondale provides the following services for its residents

- ▶ Automated residential trash collection
- ▶ Automated recycling collection
- ▶ Monthly bulk trash collection

This brochure describes the various services and schedules available to residents, and provides useful information to help you get the most out of the services available to you.

The City has issued a container for your personal use. If you move, please leave the city-owned container for the next resident.

YOUR GARBAGE COLLECTION DAYS ARE: (Coleccion de basura)

Black container (Recipiente negro)

- Mondays (Lunes)
- Tuesdays (Martes)
- Wednesdays (Miercoles)

RECYCLING COLLECTION: (Coleccion de Reciclaje)

Blue container (Recipiente azul)

- Thursdays (Jueves)
- Fridays (Viernes)

WEEKLY RESIDENTIAL SERVICE

Household refuse and recyclables are each collected once a week by an automated system. Items too large for the automated service may be set out for the monthly bulk collection.

Where: Please place your container in the street in front of your house, with the wheels touching the curb. If there is no curb, leave the container at the edge of the street closest to your home. The container must be at least 10 feet from any obstructions such as a fence, streetlight, mailbox or parked vehicles. Containers blocked by parked vehicles, or too close to obstructions will not be serviced. Once the situation is corrected, the container will be serviced on the next regularly scheduled collection date.

When: Set your container out for collection by 5 a.m. on your collection day to assure same day service or you may set your container out the evening before. Containers set out after 5 a.m. may not be serviced and must be removed from the collection location until the next regularly scheduled collection date. GARBAGE & RECYCLING HOLIDAY PICKUP SCHEDULE

The City of Avondale observes the following holidays and does not provide a collection service on that day:




BULK TRASH ZONES

MONTHLY BULK TRASH SERVICE

Each month, the City collects large, bulky items, which will not fit in the 90-gallon container.

When: Set your bulk trash out for collection by 5 a.m. on the Monday of your scheduled service week to ensure collection by the end of the week. Trash set out after 5 a.m. Monday may not be serviced until the next month. Materials may be set out no more than 24 hours before the first day of the designated collection period. If you miss the service, please remove items from view until your next service date.



Bulk E. PILE

Where: Materials set out for bulk trash collection must be placed in the street up against the curb in front of the resident's property. Where no curb is present, materials must be placed at the edge of the street. At no time may bulk trash be left on the sidewalk or on private property. Materials will not be collected from private property or when placed within 10 feet of a vehicle, mailbox, or other obstruction to safely complete collection.

ANY BOX OR CONTAINER PLACED OUT FOR COLLECTION WILL BE REMOVED AS PART OF THE UNCONTAINED MATERIAL.

BULK TRASH TIDBITS

How: Bag or box all grass clippings, leaves and small items so they do not create a litter hazard. For the safety of the collection crew, place windows and mirrors in strong boxes and set them apart from other materials.

- ▶ Brush, limbs, trunks in excess of four (4) feet in length and six (6) inches in diameter will not be collected.
- ▶ Tires, waste soil, sod, dirt, rocks, gravel, cement, concrete, masonry blocks, bricks, tile or similar materials will not be collected.
- ▶ Glass, cactus and thorny plants must be boxed or contained.
- ▶ Over the three cubic yard limit will not be collected.
- ▶ Hot ashes, hot cinders, burning matter, loose sawdust, paint products, flammable, or volatile liquids will not be collected.
- ▶ Do not put out any home remodeling or construction materials for collection. City Code requires homeowners, builders and contractors to dispose of these items privately.

The equipment that is used might leave behind small material, debris and leaves. Please sweep or rake after collection if necessary.

- ▶ Please place bulk items neatly for easy and quick pick up by crew members (limbs parallel with street).
- ▶ Please do not place multiple piles in front of home. Place all items in a single pile not to exceed 3 cubic yards.

The City of Glendale Landfill allows Avondale residents to haul their own materials there for a minimum fee. Call (623) 930-2190 for details.

Hazardous Waste Collection events are hosted twice annually. Call (623) 333-4700 or visit online for details.

BLACK GARBAGE CONTAINER TIDBITS

Will I. CLOSE

- ▶ Please bag and tie all garbage.
- ▶ Place the container with opening facing the street. Don't place on the sidewalk.
- ▶ Return container to property after collection.
- ▶ Please don't overfill (lid must be closed). Please evaluate items that qualify for the blue recycling container.
- ▶ Don't block access, leave 10 feet between can and other objects.



Note: If you need another container due to being overfilled, please call Water Billing (623) 333-2005 to order an additional black container. (Additional fee)

Prohibited materials:

- ▶ Hot ashes
- ▶ Furniture
- ▶ Large tree limbs
- ▶ Batteries, poisons and pool chemicals
- ▶ Oil-based paint and flammable fluids
- ▶ Tires, oil and other auto parts and fluids
- ▶ Appliances, water heaters, and water softeners
- ▶ Construction and remodeling debris - including rocks, dirt, concrete, bricks, tile, lumber, siding, drywall, shingles, roofing material, pipes, tar, and asphalt.
